Illness Reminder



The flu season isn't behind us yet, and there are still MANY viruses out there lurking around. If you notice any changes in your child's health, we politely ask that you take extra precaution before bringing them to CLC. We want to protect not only your family's health, but also those in the classroom and the teachers. The following are

just a few of CLC's policies when we feel your child is too ill to attend:

- **Fever of 100.4 F or higher**
- **Vomiting**
- **Consecutive loose/runny/watery or diarrhea like stools**
- **The staff feel they are not adequately able to care for your child without compromising the care of the other children also in their care at the time.**

Keep in mind, that a child must be symptom free or on an antibiotic for 24 hours. If the child was sent home with a fever, that child must be fever free for 24 hours WITHOUT fever reducing medications. We understand the need to work, and this time of year can be frustrating with all the illnesses, but we are trying to keep everyone as happy and healthy as possible! Thank you for your cooperation!
